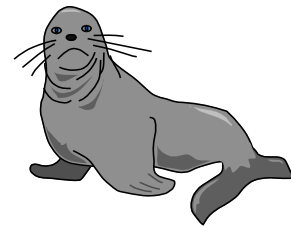


Sandhaven School Learning January 2018
